

## Stonewall Farm 2009 Garden Internship Description

Stonewall Farm is looking for two full time hard working and self motivated people to commit to the 2009 growing season. You will be surrounded by amazing energy as we are open to the public, educational in our mission, and therefore are surrounded by visitors, campers, families, and classrooms throughout the season. As a garden intern you will learn organic growing methodology from greenhouse to harvest, attend a farmer's market twice a week, stock and upkeep a farm stand and small CSA, as well as plan for and store for a winter CSA. Beginning in May and lasting thru October you will be asked to work 6 days a week: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8-6, and on market days Tuesdays and Saturdays from 6-4. In return you will be provided weekly with vegetables, one gallon of raw milk, one dozen eggs, a monthly stipend of \$300, a \$50 book allowance, admittance to the 2009 NOFA summer conference, and housing if desired. It is a shared, non-furnished old farmhouse located on site.
